13th Annual Christmas Tree Fundraiser Information

Dear Parents & Baseball Players,

Our Christmas Tree Fundraising Season is here! We have enjoyed great success in the past selling these beautiful Christmas trees to support our baseball program. This major fundraiser generated a \$10,000 profit last year and we are looking forward to another successful year. We have committed to purchasing at least 200 trees from Oregon Fresh Christmas Trees. In order to reach our goals and continue to strengthen our baseball program, we ask for the following support from each player.

Player Contribution:

- Sell a minimum of 7 trees OR 6 trees & 4 wreaths
We ask that if you are unable to sell 7 trees that you write a check for the difference in profit. On average, we make approximately \$43 per tree; but only \$10 for wreaths.
For example: if you sell 2 trees, you would also include a check for \$215.00.
- Buy out option for Christmas trees only: \$550 (\$300 for trees [7 @ \$43] and \$250 for Booster membership)
- You may also purchase trees for a family in need. See order form.

Ways Players Can Earn A Free Game Hat:

- Selling 7 or more trees
- Selling 6 trees & 4 wreaths
- Selling 5 trees & 8 wreaths
(Minimum of 5 trees must be sold first to qualify. **Any buy-outs do not qualify.**)

ORDER FORMS MUST BE RECEIVED BY Friday November 1st.

We will also notify you of other turn in times at school the last week of sales and drop off options to hand-deliver forms and checks. **PLEASE DO NOT GIVE ANY ORDER FORMS OR MONEY TO THE HIGH SCHOOL.** Checks should be made out to BOHS Baseball Boosters.

Helpful hints for Order Form and Packet information:

- Please be sure to have all information filled out at the top & bottom. Filling out your information on the order form prior to sale will save you time.
- The top half is turned in with payment, the bottom half should be given to the customer.
- Please **make a copy your order** forms before you turn them in. This will help you for delivery purposes. We need to keep the original order form for our records.
- If the "Player Pick-Up" box is checked, those order forms will be filed under the player name when YOU come to pick up the trees. You will then deliver the trees/wreaths to your customers. This is a nice touch to our service and often a great selling point! **PLAYER PICK-UP DAY is Saturday, DEC. 7th from 8-12am; however, trees will be delivered to the high school on Friday, December 6th, during practice.** Players will be expected to assist with the organization of trees once delivered and we will make best efforts (depending on time) to disseminate the trees that evening, as well.
- A price sheet is included for sales purposes.
- You have received six order forms. If you need extras, please make copies. You will also receive an email with the price sheet and order form so that you can email family and friends.
- Sales Suggestions: local businesses, neighbors, co-workers, check in with people you sold to last year, ask past players for names of people that they sold to, email the price sheet and order form to family & friends.

Parents and players, mark your calendar for Friday, December 6th and Saturday December 7th! Players will sign up to work a shift at our "Tree Lot". We will also need parents (and trucks!) to help with our tree pick-up day.
